Guildford Besom started in 2002 to help local church members to give to those who are most in need. We began with a decorating project for a family in Bellfields. Within a few months we had been given a van, a phone and use of a garage and meeting room. Since then, the van has been out and about almost every week collecting and delivering, and hundreds of people have taken part in gardening and decorating projects.

As I look back over the years, there are two words that come to mind:

The first is *Thankfulness*, thankfulness for God's amazing provision over 20 years and thankfulness to all those who have given through Besom and made a real difference to someone's life.

The second word is **Hope**. Very often on the phone we speak to people who are in despair - but as we are able to offer items for their home, or groups to help with gardening or decorating, we can sense the despair lifting and hope rising. When we visit, we are often able to pray with people too.

RECENT STORIES

We received an emergency call from a single Mum and her 9 year old daughter who had moved to an empty flat with nothing in it except a washing machine. We were able to help them with a microwave, kettle, toaster, bedding, mattresses, a chest of drawers, wardrobe and heater. We were also able to put up blinds for the windows. The Mum was so grateful, she burst into tears.

We pray regularly for the work of Besom and we love it when things come together. Recently, someone phoned in asking for a food parcel and the very next call was someone offering a food parcel. They received the much needed food the same day!



We were able to give two single mattresses to a Mum whose children were in care. With the single mattresses, it meant that the Mum now had beds for her children and they were able to stay with her just a few weeks later.
